

# Vaccinations for Allied Health Students

## Fact sheet only – not required unless you receive official notice of acceptance into a program.

Turn in **proof of vaccination to the Allied Health Department** and retain a **copy for yourself**.  
The Allied Health Office makes the first set of copies for you.

A \$1.00 per page fee is charged for subsequent copies.

Vaccination	Information
<b>Hepatitis B (Hep B)</b>	This vaccine is to protect you from the risk of hepatitis B virus infection. The vaccine is given in 3 doses. Dose #2, 30 days after 1 <sup>st</sup> dose. Dose #3 six months after 1 <sup>st</sup> dose. Provided by the Health Department. Fee Varies.
<b>Varicella (chickenpox)</b>	For healthcare personnel (HCP) who have no serologic proof of immunity or prior vaccination, give 2 doses of varicella vaccine, 30 days apart. Provided by the Health Department. Fee Varies. If you do not wish to get the vaccination, you may have your doctor run an immunity titer. If you are immune, you will not need the vaccination.
<b>MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)</b>	For healthcare personnel (HCP) born in 1957 or later without serologic evidence of immunity or prior vaccination, give 2 doses of MMR, 30 days apart. Provided by the Health Department. Fee Varies. If you do not wish to get the vaccination, you can have your doctor run an immunity titer. If you are immune, you will not need the vaccination.
<b>Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (TdaP)</b>	A 1-time dose of "TdaP" vaccine (the adult whooping cough vaccine) is required. If you have already been vaccinated, a TdaP booster is necessary every 10 years.
<b>Influenza</b>	A dose is required every fall (or winter) for your protection and for the protection of others around you. This vaccination is required before clinical rotation.
<b>Two-step TB Skin Test Or T-Spot</b>	You will need <b>two TB tests</b> (or a T-Spot test) at least one week apart. Must be annually tested once every 12 months after initial two-step testing. Omni Health and Wal-Mart clinics provide this testing.

**Current Healthcare Provider CPR certification (adult, child and infant) is required and should be obtained before entering the program.** Certification must be current throughout the duration of the program. (Not needed for Hearing Instrument Science or Medical Laboratory Technician)

EMT-Basic will need Hepatitis B and Healthcare Provider CPR
