The OTC EMT program provides Advanced Placement for qualified students. Advanced placement is any process where the EMT program formally recognizes prior learning of a student and applies that recognition toward meeting the program requirements. Advanced placement is applied on a case-by-case basis and allows a student to “place out” of specified program didactic, laboratory, clinical, or field internship requirements. This may shorten the time for completion of the program and is often thought of as an alternative pathway to program completion and eligibility for the National Registry or state examination at the paramedic level. These types of students often include physicians, registered nurses, licensed EMT Basics, Advanced EMTs, Intermediates and Paramedics.

All students completing the program must demonstrate they have met ALL program requirements. Therefore, documentation of any student completing via an advanced placement policy must show how all of the program minimum didactic, laboratory, clinical and field requirements have been achieved through this process. All students, including those in advanced placement, completing the program are considered graduates and will be included in all outcomes reporting.
