- 1. Roster clean-up now happens on day 10 of the semester, instead of day 14. This semester that date is **Wednesday, August 30**. For those of you teaching online classes, please make sure you have an assignment for students to complete prior to day 10 (and encourage them to complete it).
- 2. Because of some IT updates, the process for completing roster clean-up has changed. You will receive detailed instructions for how to complete roster clean-up from Dr. Gavin O'Connor sometime before August 30. Keep an eye on your OTC email!
