Dual Credit: Why is it Important?

High School - MSIP 5

 Successful completion Dual Credit (seated) & Dual Enrollment (online) course work

OTC –College Success & Student Retention

- Twice as likely to enroll in college
- 11% more likely to persist through the second year of college
- Twice as likely to earn a degree
- Earn higher GPA compared to non dual credit students (3.13 to 2.97)
- OTC More than 50% enroll in a class after high school



Enrollment Partnerships

- 65 total schools
 - 41 offer online options
 - 38 offer seated classes
 - Some combination of both
 - Homeschool & private school
- For Fall 2016
 - 37 seated classes
 - 84 online classes

Let's Compare!

Institution	Tuition	Remuneration
OTC	\$35 per credit hour	\$25 per credit hour
MSU	\$70 per credit hour	\$25?
Drury University	\$70 per credit hour	\$25?



Remuneration = Money Back

- OTC Dual Credit remunerates (gives back)
 \$25 per credit hour for students who successfully complete seated classes
 - after final grades entered/submitted by instructor
- High school determines . . .
 - pay instructor
 - pay for textbooks/materials
 - administrative costs



Accreditation & Policies

- Accredited by Higher Learning Commission (HLC)
 - Transfer not if, but how
- Missouri Department of Higher Education (MDHE)





HLC & MDHE Policies

- Academic Integrity Standards

 - Once a year for first two years
 - Once every two years thereafter

 - CIS V BUS



Let's Compare!

- Dual Credit Tuition
 - \$35 per credit hour, plus \$65 online fee
 - 3 credit hour seated = \$105
 - 3 credit hour online = \$170
- OTC Tuition
 - In-district, 3 credit hour = approx. \$500
 - Out-of-district, 3 credit hour = approx. \$600

Savings = \$395 to \$495

Seated

At the high school by an approved high school instructor

Online

- Taught through Blackboard by an OTC instructor during a high school block
- Same tuition, plus \$65 online fee

One class, twice the credit!*



Admission Steps

- ✓ Guided Self-Placement English, math & science

Admission Steps

Special Note:

- If approved for a year long class, begin teaching the OTC curriculum, objectives, and utilizing the approved textbook in the fall semester.
- Students will start the admission steps late in the fall semester, then pay tuition and earn the college credit in the spring semester.
