Electrical Distribution Systems Program (EDS) How to Apply

Admissions Overview for EDS:

The Electrical Distribution Systems (EDS) program is a 2-year Associates of Applied Science degree and a selective admissions program. This means that after you apply to OTC and declare EDS as your major, you will need to go through an application process to get a spot in the next fall cohort. Currently there is no chance to start the degree in the spring semester. We use a points-based system for selecting applicants and once you have sent your contact information to EDS@otc.edu you will receive the current application information for review.

EDS cohorts:

If you are interested in joining the next fall group to start, please send an email to EDS@otc.edu with your name, phone number, preferred email, and any other pertinent information you would like to share. Applications will be open January 1 through the first Tuesday in June and after the close of the application period we will tally the application scores and notify all applicants of their status. You will receive a verification of receipt for all electronic submissions and you should inquire if you do not receive such. This is to ensure no applications are lost.

To apply follow the steps below:

Step 1: Send your contact information to EDS@otc.edu to receive the current digital application packet.

Step 2: Review the Electrical Distribution Systems FAQ, Application Process, Block Diagram, and Student Copy of Application Rubric documents.

Step 3: Apply to OTC and begin working through your FASFA and other financial aid requirements.

Step 4: Send your DOT physical, Drug screen, Driving record, one page essay, and any other supporting materials to EDS@otc.edu

Step 5: Monitor your OTC email account as all official communications must be sent there.
