
Written Instructions for Account Creation and Application

**Dual Credit students should skip ahead to the 2:58 mark and hit play when you see Ozarks Technical Community College – Application for Admission. (As seen below)


This is a 2 Step process, but it should take you no longer than 10 minutes to complete both steps!



STEP 1 – CREATE ACCOUNT!




Enter an email address – DO not use your High School email address. You will want to use an email you will have access to AFTER you graduate High School.







Your Assigned OTC Username will be automatically generated. Please make a note of this, you will use it often. We recommend taking a picture of it to save in your phone.






Type of student (While in high school) "These programs are not eligible for financial aid O Career Center** (Students spend half-day at the OTC Campus in a technical program of study and the other half-day at their home high schools. Juniors or seniors attending Ash Grove, Bolivar, Clever, Everton, Fair Grove, Fordland, Marion C Early, Marshfield, Nixa, Pleasant Hope, Republic, Logan Rogersville, Seymour, Sparta, Springfield, Strafford, Walnut Grove, or Willard are eligible to attend the Springfield Campus. Juniors or seniors attending Branson and Hollister are eligible to attend limited programs at Table Rock Campus. Additionally, Career Center Ag program now available at ition is paid for by the sending school Dual Credit** (Students 16 years of age and older can enroll in select college classes, at their high school or online, for a reduced tuition cost. See your school representative for class and payment options, along with how college classes count toward high school credits. Classes are available in fall and spring only.) ** (Students 16 years of age and older can enoll in college class subjects of their choosing, at any OTC Students self-pay at the regular Orc. O College Now** (Formerly FastTrack)(Students from select high schools - Hollister, Laquey, Ozark, or Waynesville - can participate in classes at an OTC location or online. The high school pays for tuition and fees, and approves the course subjects and format.) Middle College** (Students attend both high school and college classes on the Springfield campus working towards an Associate of Arts degree or a pathway within career and technical education. Juniors and seniors attending Central, Glendale, Hillcrest, Kickapoo, Parkview, Logan-Rogersville, Nixa, Sparta, or Everton are eligible to apply. Tuition is paid for by the sending school district upon acceptance.)
