APPLICATION DEADLINES:

- **USE OUR NEW ONLINE APPLICATION PORTAL TO APPLY:** apply.otc.edu
- **Note: You can START your online application now, but you will not be able to SUBMIT a complete application until you have taken your HESI exam. (Check the HESI exam window dates below.)**
- **Springfield: May 1st** – This Traditional Hybrid cohort begins in the fall semester (August).
- **Table Rock: September 1st** - This Traditional Hybrid cohort begins in the fall semester (B Block - October).
- **Springfield and Lebanon: October 1st** – These Traditional Hybrid cohorts begin in the spring semester (January).
- **Springfield Advanced Hybrid cohort: October 1st** - This cohort begins in spring semester (January).

The Practical Nursing Program is a selective admission program and admission is determined by a points-based system. Points are accumulated on grades made in Anatomy and Physiology, HESI test score, and references. An incomplete file will not be considered. Complete the following by the application deadline:

- Complete OTC admissions process. Visit www.otc.edu/start-here
- Complete preadmission courses. See Preferred Course Sequence [HERE](#) for specific requirements. (If a passing grade is not achieved after two attempts in any program preadmission requirement, an applicant may not be considered for the program. Please email healthsciences@otc.edu to request additional information.)
- Official transcripts from accredited schools attended other than OTC must be received by OTC Admissions before the application deadline.**
- START the ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS, apply.otc.edu. (Note: You will not be able to SUBMIT your application until you have taken your HESI Admission Assessment Exam.)**
- Provide 3 professional references as a part of the new online application process by the application deadline. One reference must be from your Anatomy or Physiology instructor.
- Complete HESI Admission Assessment Exam **during your testing window**. Upload the results to **[complete and submit](#)** your online application. (See additional information about testing windows below.)
- The TOEFL is required by student if English is not student's primary language. (See additional information below.)
- If applying to the Advanced Hybrid Track (prior CNA/MA/EMT experience required), complete the work verification form [HERE](#) and upload the form during the online application process.

HESI ADMISSION ASSESSMENT EXAM:

- ✓ A minimum overall score of 70% must be achieved on the HESI Admission Assessment Exam to be considered for the program.
- ✓ This test will be delivered seated or online.
- ✓ Student will have 4 hours to complete testing.

- ✓ HESI Exam instructions will be provided during the online application process when students **START** their application for the Practical Nursing program. (HESI Testing Step-by-Step instructions can also be found on the Testing Services page: [OTC Students HESI Testing - OTC Springfield Testing Services](#)) This test may be attempted twice during each test cycle outlined below:
 - *March 1 – May 1 (for the May1 deadline)*
 - *July 1 – September 1 (for the September 1 deadline)*
 - *August 1 – October 1 (for the October 1 deadline)*
- ✓ The cost is \$75.00 per test online, and \$37.00 per test seated.

BEHAVIORAL ASSESSMENT:

- Only students who complete the online application process and meet the admission parameters by the cohort deadline are eligible.
- Those students will receive an invitation to a canvas course called “NUR-Admissions.” Students should accept the invitation immediately.
- Students will be given one week to complete and submit the Behavioral Assessment. This is the final component of the admission process.
- Students in the Advanced Hybrid cohort are exempt from this requirement.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT

Students whose primary language is not English must document their English language proficiency. This requires:

- Minimum TOEFL iBT passing score of 83, with a minimum speaking score of 26. Students must satisfy this requirement by submitting a current TOEFL iBT score (Test of English as a Foreign Language) **during the online application process.**
- Students should register for testing using the [TOEFL](#) website, but only tests administered in a professional test center are accepted.
- The TOEFL report scores are valid for 2 years from the test date.
- This is separate from the test taken to be admitted to OTC.

NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTANCE:

- Based upon the program’s admission scoring system, the top applicants will be offered a position in the program and will receive information on the necessary steps to complete the program admission.
- Students will be notified of acceptance or non-acceptance into the program via the online application portal.
- Those students who have accepted positions will be emailed the acceptance packet task list to complete the admission process.

REAPPLICATION:

- ✓ Applicants and alternates not selected for admission can reapply online for the next deadline.
