MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)	 ✓ 2 doses are required ✓ Dose #2 required 30 days after dose #1 ✓ Instead of immunizations student may opt for a titer to prove immunity ✓ If not immune, student must start the series
Varicella (chickenpox)	 ✓ 2 doses are required ✓ Dose #2 required 30 days after dose #1 ✓ Instead of immunizations student may opt for a titer to prove immunity ✓ If not immune, student must start the series
TdaP (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis	✓ 1 dose required ✓ Booster required every 10 years after 1 st dose
Influenza (Subject to clinical site requirement)	✓ 1 dose required every fall
Covid (Subject to clinical site requirement)	✓ Dosage required by vaccine manufacturer
