HEALTH SCIENCES PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES

The two-year Health Sciences Program offers the junior and senior level highschool student the ability to make decisions about their future in the healthcare industry while receiving high-school and college credit.

The **first year** Health Sciences experience provides students with the fundamental healthcare concepts that can be transferred to many of the healthcare careers.

The **second year** Health Sciences student has the opportunity to perform a more in depth study of their career choice and enroll in the DHSS approved MO Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) program. The CNA clinical rotations provide the opportunity for the student to apply their knowledge in a hands-on capacity. They also experience an extensive service learning course which allows them to give back to the community. After completion of two years and meeting all the DHSS requirements, the students may become CNA certified.

In addition, the clinical rotations provide the opportunity for the student to discuss the career with local professionals in their chosen area of interest.
