

Thank you for considering an Allied Health program at Ozarks Technical Community College!

Below are some helpful hints & updates that may be helpful in your application process.

Hints

- *Read over the application checklist carefully!*
 - ✓ *Missing items = incomplete file*
- *If you are an international student, you must visit the International Student office within Student Services.*
- *Check with the Allied Health Office to be sure that your file is complete before the application deadline by calling (417) 447-8803.*
- *It is ok to get more than three references*
 - ✓ *Higher scores will be used for points*
- *Applications can be reused if you are not accepted the first time*
 - ✓ *You will be notified by mail whether you have been accepted or not*
 - ✓ *Contact the Allied Health office to renew your application*
 - ✓ *The application fee (\$15.00) is valid for two application cycles*
 - ✓ *The application fee is non-refundable, no exceptions*
- *The BCS degree is not the same as an Allied Health program degree--This is used for transfer to another college or to receive financial aid until accepted into your chosen program*

- Allied Health programs will only allow an applicant to complete a pre-admission course twice in an attempt to receive a C or better as the final grade.

Updates

- ❖ Application Packets:

 - Read through the application checklist carefully. This is found in the Application Packet link.
- ❖ Documents for students accepted into programs will be emailed to the student's OTC email account.
 - ✓ Make sure this email account is active and access it to familiarize yourself.
 - ✓ Letters of congratulations and regret letters will be mailed to the address listed on a student's Allied Health application.
