The Certificate of Achievement in Hearing Instrument Science (CT-HIS) track is designed for professionals who are already licensed and interested in gaining a deeper knowledge of the hearing systems. It is also appropriate for students who are working towards licensing in a state that does not require an Associate's degree. (Refer to your state guidelines for this information.)

HEARING INSTRUMENT SCIENCE

The Hearing Instrument Science Program includes online courses and hybrid courses. Hybrid courses will require live video conferencing during lab sessions for students out of state. Students living in the state of Missouri will be required to come to our Springfield campus for lab sessions. Labs are held twice a semester on a Friday and Saturday. No labs are held during the summer semester.

To be eligible to apply students must have HIS-110, HIS-120, HIS-130, and HIS-140 completed or in-progress. Refer to the preferred course sequence on our website to see when those courses are offered. Students must also complete an interview with a HIS faculty member and have a course plan approved by the Program Director prior to applying.
