

Vaccinations for Allied Health Students

Fact Sheet Only – not required unless student receives official notice of acceptance into a program – This list is subject to change

The following vaccinations & TB testing are required to complete clinical rotation.

Turn in **proof of vaccination to the Allied Health Department** and retain a **copy for yourself**. The Allied Health Office makes the first set of copies for you.

A \$1.00 per page fee is charged for subsequent copies.

| Vaccination | Information |
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| *Hepatitis B | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 3 doses are required ✓ Dose 2 given 30 days after dose 1 ✓ Dose 3 given 5 months after dose 2 ✓ Instead of immunizations student may opt for a titer to prove immunity – if not immune student must start the series |
| Varicella (chickenpox) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 2 doses are required – 30 days apart ✓ Required even if student had chicken pox ✓ Instead of immunizations student may opt for a titer to prove immunity – if not immune, student must start the series |
| *MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 2 doses are required – 30 days apart ✓ Required even if student had childhood disease(s) ✓ Instead of immunizations student may opt for a titer to prove immunity – if not immune, student must start the series |
| Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (TdaP) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 1 dose required ✓ Booster required every 10 years after 1st dose |
| Influenza | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 1 dose required every fall (or winter) |
| *Two-step TB Skin Test Or T-Spot | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Two TB tests required – one week apart ✓ Student may opt for a T-Spot to prove negative for TB ✓ If it has been 4 months since first test, student must start testing over ✓ TB testing or T-Spot is required every 12 months |

***These are the only requirements for the Behavioral Health Support Program and the Hearing Instrument Science Program.**
