Certification as a Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT) is achieved by passing the national certification examination administered through the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA). Graduates of accredited Health Information Technology programs are eligible to sit for the RHIT examination.

The OTC Health Information Technology (HIT) program's students and graduates *consistently exceed* the Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT) certification exam national pass rate.
