

MSU-OTC Business Access Program

Ozarks Technical Community College and the College of Business Administration at Missouri State University have cooperated to create a program allowing Ozarks Technical Community College students to be simultaneously admitted to a business program at Missouri State University.

This program is intended to better serve business students transferring from Ozarks Technical Community College to Missouri State University.

Student Benefits

Establishing Goals

Beginning your college career with a clear direction promotes academic persistence and increases potential for success. With the Business Access Program you can receive updated reports on your progress and measure your advancement toward your educational goals.

Transitions

The smaller environment of a community college offers many and varied benefits. Among those benefits is adjustment to collegiate life and study, which will place you in a better position to succeed at Missouri State University.

Academic Advising Assistance

Your advisors will work cooperatively to assist you in the design of an appropriate transfer program, and in paving the way to an easy and efficient transfer experience.

Semester Updates

Upon submission of a copy of your transcript each semester, you will be notified of the courses that will be accepted for transfer. You will also be notified of your progress toward fulfillment of the requirements for a business major at Missouri State University. A summary of requirements fulfilled and those still remaining will be provided.

General Education

Upon successful completion of the Associate of Arts degree at Ozarks Technical Community College, the lower division General Education requirements at Missouri State University will be considered met. Otherwise, coursework will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis and applied to Missouri State University's business degree as appropriate. All upper-division major program requirements should be taken at Missouri State University.

Eligibility Requirements

Application Eligibility

To participate in the Business Access Program, you must be eligible for admission to Ozarks Technical Community College, as determined by their admission standards and requirements. Once admitted to Ozarks Technical Community College, you are eligible to apply for the Business Access Program at Missouri State University. Simply complete and return the "Application for Business Access Program to Missouri State University, College of Business Administration."

Transfer Eligibility

A transfer student is defined as a student who has completed high school graduation requirements and who will have earned 24 or more hours of transferable college credit after completion of high school graduation requirements. At the time of transfer to Missouri State University's College of Business Administration, you must have a 2.50 minimum cumulative grade point average on all transferable college courses. [Note: you may be admitted to Missouri State University with a minimum grade point average of 2.0, but guaranteed admission to the business program requires a 2.50]

Admission Process

You should file an official application for admission during your final semester at Ozarks Technical Community College in order to be tentatively admitted. Official transcripts from all previous institutions verifying the minimum required cumulative grade point average must be on file before admission is considered complete. Students with fewer than 24 transferable credit hours must also have an official high school transcript and an ACT score on file at Missouri State University.

Two+Three Program

The College of Business also offers a Two+Three Program for highly motivated students who have the ultimate goal of completing the Master's of Business Administration (MBA) from Missouri State University. Through the Two+Three Program, a student can complete the Associates, Bachelor's and Master's degrees in a total of five years (two years at OTC and three years at Missouri State University). The Two+Three Program follows the same application eligibility as the Business Access Program. However, to be admitted into the Two+Three Program a student must have and maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 and earn a minimum score of 450 on the GMAT examination at the time of application to the Accelerated Master's Program, which is typically the first semester of the senior year.
