Articulation Agreement Evangel University & Ozarks Technical Community College Associate of Applied Science in Behavioral Health Support

Purpose. This is an articulation of an agreement to accept Ozarks Technical Community College graduates with an Associate of Applied Science in Behavioral Health Support into the Bachelor of Science in Behavioral Health program at Evan gel University (EU). This agreement details the courses that will be accepted in transfer from Ozarks Technical Community College (OTC) and applied toward course requirements. It also lists courses remaining for these students to complete in order to obtain the Bachelor of Science in Behavioral Health. We have done this by comparing the program plan for the OTC degree to our program plan at EU and reviewing course descriptions at the two schools.

Provisions. It is assumed that all courses and credits accepted in transfer will have grades of C or better associated with them. All courses meeting this requirement will transfer to EU. Of the 63 hours completed at OTC, a significant number of hours will apply directly toward completion of the requirements for the 48 hours of the Behavioral Health major. Many of the remaining hours will be applied toward the General Education requirements of the university.

Program Specifics. Required courses for Evangel University students to graduate with a bachelor's degree include 50 hours of general education courses and 26 hours of electives along with 48 hours in a comprehensive major for 124 credit hours total. We believe OTC students matriculating at Evangel will have completed 25 of the required general education hours requirements and have an additional 25 hours remaining to be completed. These remaining courses are listed in table 1. Twelve hours of courses completed in the Behavioral Health Support program at OTC will also be applied to the Behavioral Health Degree at EU. These courses are listed in table 2. The remaining 36 credits to be taken while at EU in the Behavioral Health program are listed in table 3. The total number of credit hours remaining to be completed at Evangel University by OTC studies completing the AAS in Behavioral Health Support is 61 hours.
