

Honors Transfer and Articulation Agreement

Purpose

This agreement is to facilitate the transfer of students between the Ozarks Technical Community College Honors Program and the Drury University Honors Program in Drury's Day School.

Agreement

- The first four OTC Honors students with a 3.75 grade point average who have successfully completed the OTC Honors Program and who have been admitted to Drury University will be automatically admitted to the Drury University Honors Program upon completing the Honors Program application in a given academic year. If there are additional spaces available, the Drury University Honors Program will admit additional OTC Honors students.
- OTC Honors students who graduate with a grade point average of less than 3.75 will need to apply to Drury's Honors Program on an individual basis and will need to include a recommendation letter from the OTC Honors Director as part of their application.
- OTC Honors students will complete the Accelerated Honors Program at Drury University and can apply up to 6 honors credit hours from OTC to the 21 required honors hours for the Honors Degree.
- OTC Honors students must earn an A or a B in any OTC honors class for it to be used to meet Drury Honors Program requirements.
- OTC Honors students who are accepted into Drury University Honors Program will receive a scholarship of \$4,000 per year beyond their academic scholarship (as determined by Drury's Transfer Student Scholarship Grid). Both awards are renewable for up to

six semesters.

- Both institutions will remain active members of the Great Plains Honors Council and the National Collegiate Honors Council.
- Notice of Change or Cancellation: Either institution may change or cancel this agreement by notifying the other no less than one academic year before the intended date of change or cancellation.
