

Articulation Agreement between

Southwest Baptist University and Ozarks Technical Community College

This Agreement is entered into between **Ozarks Technical Community College** (hereinafter sending institution), and **Southwest Baptist University** (hereinafter receiving institution). This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Missouri.

The sending institution has established an **Associate of Arts degree** (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established a **Bachelor of Arts degree and a Bachelor of Science degree** (hereinafter receiving program), and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another. It is mutually agreed:

Admission Requirements

- A. The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. The student must meet admission requirements that exist at the time of application in order to obtain entry to the receiving institution (which may or may not be different from those in place at the time of this agreement.)

Transfer of Credits

- A. The receiving institution will accept a minimum of 62 credits from the sending program. A minimum of 66 total credits remain to complete the receiving program.
- B. The student must complete an Associate's degree with the sending institution, in order for this agreement to be utilized.
- C. Courses will transfer as described in the attached Program Articulation Table.

Implementation and Review

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 6/01/2019 and shall remain in effect until the end date of 06/01/2024 unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- C. The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either program occur while the agreement is in effect.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning 11/01/2023
- E. When a student notifies the receiving institution of their intent to follow this agreement, the receiving institution will encode course waivers and substitutions.




 - SPF 2012 Spiritual Formations, BIB 1013 Old Testament History, and BIB 1023 New Testament History are required for graduation.
 - Successful completion of Chapel (CLW) requirements for semesters enrolled at SBU.
 - A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.00 for courses taken while enrolled at Southwest Baptist University.
 - Successful completion of the Southwest Baptist University graduation requirements for the degree.
- The following limitations also apply:
 - Developmental courses shall not be counted toward graduation.
