

## Articulation Agreement between

### Southwest Baptist University and Ozarks Technical Community College

This Agreement is entered into between Ozarks Technical Community College (hereinafter sending institution), and Southwest Baptist University (hereinafter receiving institution). This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Missouri.

The sending institution has established an Honors Program, and the receiving institution has established an Honors Program, and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another. It is mutually agreed:

#### Admission Requirements

- A. The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. The student must meet admission requirements that exist at the time of application in order to obtain entry to the receiving institution (which may or may not be different from those in place at the time of this agreement).

#### Transfer of Credits

- A. The receiving institution will accept 64 credits from the sending program. A total of 3 credits remain to complete course requirements of the receiving program.

#### Implementation and Review

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 10/01/2016 and shall remain in effect until the end date of 06/01/2021 unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- C. The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either program occur while the agreement is in effect.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning 11/01/2020.
- E. When a student notifies the receiving institution of their intent to follow this agreement, the receiving institution will encode course waivers and substitutions.



 Students who complete the Honors Program at OTC will have a completed AS or AA degree. For students with an AA degree, the 42-hour general education block will be completed at SBU. For students with an AS degree, the courses will transfer course-by-course and remaining general education hours will be dependent upon the major of study chosen by the student.

**Special Notes, if any:**

- Southwest Baptist University requires:
  - o A minimum of 32 credits must be taken at Southwest Baptist University
  - o A minimum of 40 credits at the 3000 or 4000 level.
  - o SPF 2012 Spiritual Formations, BIB 1013 Old Testament History, and BIB 1023 New Testament History are required for graduation.
  - o Successful completion of Chapel (CLW) requirements for semesters enrolled at SBU.
  - o A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.00 for courses taken while enrolled at Southwest Baptist University.
  - o Successful completion of the Southwest Baptist University graduation requirements for the degree.
- The following limitations also apply:
  - o Developmental courses shall not be counted toward graduation.
